An Act Eliminating Preliminary Elections In Revere 2009.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall be no preliminary
- 2 elections in the City of Revere as otherwise required on September 15, 2009 for the office of School
- 3 Committee for a 2 year term and for the office of City Council for a 2 year term. All candidates whose
- 4 nomination papers have been duly certified shall be deemed to have been nominated, and their names
- 5 shall appear on the General Election Ballot
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
